### Specials Courses

#### ART

In ART we imagine, freely create, and learn about art. We are able to communicate ideas in a collaborative and respectful environment. We learn about the elements of art, explore a variety of art mediums and styles. In class, we critically think and reflect upon our learning. We grow from our mistakes. We embrace one another's perspectives as we grow into creative individuals.

#### MUSIC

The Fox Hollow music program involves: singing songs, creating movement, learning to play and create rhythms celebrating cultural diversity, playing recorders, ukulele, and choir chimes, while integrating Orff, and other music philosophies.

#### TECHNOLOGY

Students create projects that build upon each other and a variety of technology skills. Projects include digital art, animation, video editing, website creations, 3D printing software, coding, digital citizenship, internet research and Google for Education

#### STEM

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) provides students with opportunities to design, create, test and improve solutions in real-world contexts. Students in STEM class collaboratively engage in scientific inquiry and the engineering design process to become creative and critical thinkers

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Students learn to be active for a lifetime! We focus on body movement through different sports and activities.
