

**Fox Hollow PTO Welcomes  
You to Kindergarten!!!**



Hello Kindergarten Families!

Welcome to Fox Hollow. We understand that many of you are new to the school and the Fox Hollow PTO wants to help you feel welcomed and stay connected. There are a few events we want to let you know about in order to help you be well informed as the school year begins.

1. **Kindergarten Orientation Night** - Thursday April 12th, 2018 6:30-7:30 p.m. The principal generally speaks for a short time and introduces some of the staff. You will get to see the kindergarten classrooms and meet the teachers at this event. If you have a child who will need meds during the school day, the nurse will have the appropriate forms for you to fill out and return at the start of school. There will also be information on before and after school care (Discovery Club) as well as the Kindergarten Enrichment Program (KEP).
2. **Check in day**- Friday August 10th, 2018. Check-in times are assigned alphabetically. Visit the Fox Hollow website or refer to your kindergarten round up brochure for check in times. Please make sure to stop by the PTO table so we can give you a calendar of social events as well as the general school calendar.
3. **Kindergarten Coffee** - Kindergarten parents are invited to congregate in the library after a.m. drop off on the first day of school for kindergarteners. This is purely a social event and an opportunity to get to know other parents. Younger siblings are welcome to attend.
4. **Community Picnic** - This is an opportunity to meet other families at Fox Hollow. Bring a picnic dinner for your family. Fox Hollow PTO will provide popsicles. There are no formal introductions or speakers at this event. The principal will be present to meet families. Date and location TBD.
5. **Back to School Night** - This is an opportunity to hear from your child's teacher about the curriculum and what activities your child will be doing in the classroom throughout the year. Most teachers will hand out the class schedule and explain the expectations for the year. Some teachers provide a volunteer sign up for parents who wish to help in the classroom or from home. You will also have an opportunity to ask questions during this event. Two sessions are provided for parents with multiple children, or you may split time between classrooms.

***Here are some helpful ways to stay plugged in to what is happening with the Fox Hollow PTO***

- Sign up and read the PTO email blast that goes out every other Friday. This will provide information on our social events as well as update on our two main fundraisers each year. The Fun Run is our Fall fundraising event and Funds for Excellence is our spring fundraiser. You will receive more information on these events as they approach. An email sign up sheet will be provided at registration day and one will be sent home in your child's folder.

It also provides a schedule of what activities and clubs are meeting after school.
- Look for announcements in your child's communication folder that will come home on Thursday. The front office and your child's teacher will send home announcements as needed in this folder.
